



Discipline Policy

Overview

Anacortes Christian School follows the Bible's guidance for student discipline, in particular these key verses:

- Ephesians 6:1-4 - Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. "Honor your father and mother" (this is the first commandment with a promise), "that it may go well with you and that you may live long in the land." Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.
- Proverbs 22:6 - Start children off on the way they should go, and even when they are old, they will not turn from it.
- Matthew 18:21-22 - Then Peter came up and said to him, "Lord, how often will my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? As many as seven times?" Jesus said to him, "I do not say to you seven times, but seventy-seven times."

Discipline

Anacortes Christian School follows the Bible's guidance in dealing with offenses, in particular Mathew 18:15-17. We will work with both the parents, teacher, and students to resolve issues in a manner that glorifies God. If a student continues to misbehave, disciplinary actions can include but are not limited to: detention, fines, community service, suspension, and expulsion.

Offenses

Offenses include but are not limited to:

- Minor: Tardiness, inappropriate dress, running inside the building, being out of class without a hall pass, eating or drinking in class, and use of cell phone during the school day.
- Major: Lying, disobedience, disrespecting faculty or peer, fighting, inappropriate language, bringing dangerous objects to school such as weapons, vandalism, drug use, inappropriate physical contact, theft, and cheating.
