Welcome

Welcome to Anacortes Christian School (ACS)! We are thrilled you are considering ACS for your student and we are excited to show you all that our wonderful school has to offer! ACS will offer Preschool through 4th grade this year with plans to expand the school at least one grade per year, every year.

We believe that ACS fills a void that has long existed in Anacortes and that the children of Anacortes deserve a Christian education where Truth and Life are infused into all aspects of their learning. We understand that your children you put in our care are the most important beings in your life and we take seriously treating them as such. Our teachers, staff, and volunteers are all committed to providing each and every student with a high-quality learning environment rich in love, support and purpose. Throughout this handbook we will go into depth on all the ins and outs of what we are all about.

General Info

- For the '25-'26 academic year, there will two classrooms:
 - o Preschool (3s and 4s)
 - Combined K-4th classroom
- All classrooms will have a head teacher and a teacher's assistant as well intermittent volunteers.
- We will cap the classrooms at 15 full-time equivalent students.

Mission and Vision

Anacortes Christian School offers a Christian education deeply rooted in the Word of God. Here's what were all about:

<u>Mission</u>: To provide an excellent, holistic education, rooted in the infallible word of God, that will equip students to be a Light in the world.

<u>Vision</u>: To raise up a new generation of strong Christians who will lead revival in our community, state, nation, and world by the power of the Holy Spirit.

- 1. **Excellence** We are committed to delivering exceptional quality in both our physical learning spaces and the education itself.
- 2. **Truth** We hold the belief that the Word represents ultimate truth, and we use it as a guiding force to make all our decisions.

3. **Purpose** - We believe that God has a meaningful purpose for each individual, and our aim is to help our staff and students identify their unique gifts and use them to honor God.

Academics

We will offer preschool through 4th grade for the '25-'26 school year with plans to continue expanding at least one grade per year to keep up with the oldest class. Our classes will be capped at 15 students this year.

Electives

One thing that sets ACS apart is our engaging, hands-on special electives. There are weekly "electives" like art, social studies, science and of course the Friday Forest Adventure, but we also shuffle through "special" elective blocks throughout the school year. In the '24-'25 year, we did electronics, dance & movement and home-ec.

Philosophy of Education

We believe that God created this world and all that is in it: mathematics, language, reading, writing, science, social studies, play, recess, and so much more; it all only exists because of a loving Creator. So, to learn about the creation but omit the Creator is to miss the most important part of learning. So, at ACS, not only will students receive the highest quality of education, but they will also learn about the God who created them, the love He has for them, and the purpose that He has for their lives. A big part of achieving this is through real-life experiences! Learning about who God is and about His creation through books, worksheets, and projects has great value, but we also know that children especially learn through hands-on experience. Whether it is fun cut-out art projects, adventuring in the Anacortes forest lands, or making cookies during home-ec elective, students are always encouraged to learn through their curiosity. We find that a healthy balance of classwork and hands-on cultivates the best education environment and so that is what we strive for.

Structure

ACS follows a traditional school approach where students progress through grades. However, we often combine two or three consecutive grades into one classroom. Our experience with multi-grade classrooms has been outstanding, with younger students looking up to and learning from older students while the older students get opportunities to lead, mentor, and teach, solidifying past curricula in their minds.

Although students progress through grades, because of small class sizes, we can afford a more tailored education. If a student is excelling in one topic but not another, we can pace them

faster in the topic they are strong in instead of holding them back to the lowest common denominator.

Bible

Our dedicated bible time each day is wonderful for our students, but we believe that students learn best from experience and good modeling. This is why our teachers infuse prayer, Jesus' love, and biblical principles throughout all topics. Our heart is to be a resource to all people in our community that are seeking a high-quality Christian education which is why we remain non-denominational with our bible lessons. For questions that can be debated between denominations, we refer students to their pastors and parents. See our Statement of Faith below.

Core Topics

ACS Elementary focuses primarily on teaching students to excel in the "Three R's": writing, reading, and arithmetic. Additionally, as part of delivering a holistic education, we supplement with science, art, PE, performing arts, Socratic discussion, and of course play! Apart from traditional worksheets and projects, our teachers will often walk students through experiential learning activities where they engage in hands-on activities to make the learning experience more visceral and to root the teaching deep in their minds.

Parent-Teacher Communication





Admissions Process

Policies

Discipline

Anacortes Christian School follows the Bible's guidance for student discipline, in particular these key verses:

- Ephesians 6:1-4 Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. "Honor your father and mother" (this is the first commandment with a promise), "that it may go well with you and that you may live long in the land." Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.
- Proverbs 22:6 Start children off on the way they should go, and even when they are old, they will not turn from it.
- Matthew 18:15-17 If your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault, between you and him alone. If he listens to you, you have gained your brother. But if he does not listen, take one or two others along with you, that every charge may be established by the evidence of two or three witnesses. If he refuses to listen to them, tell it to the church. And if he refuses to listen even to the church, let him be to you as a Gentile and a tax collector.
- Matthew 18:21-22 Then Peter came up and said to him, "Lord, how often will my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? As many as seven times?" Jesus said to him, "I do not say to you seven times, but seventy-seven times.

We will work with both the parents, teacher, and students to resolve issues in a manner that glorifies God.

Statement of Faith

- 1. We believe in the Bible as the inspired and infallible Word of God.
- 2. We believe in one God, eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son, and the Holy Spirit.
- 3. We believe in the virgin birth of Jesus Christ and in His death, resurrection and ascension.
- 4. We believe that man, by voluntary transgression, fell and thereby incurred physical death and separation from God.
- 5. We believe in salvation through the blood of Jesus Christ as man's <u>only</u> hope of redemption.
- 6. We believe in water baptism through immersion and the partaking of Holy Communion as a memorial of His suffering and death.
- 7. We believe in the power of the Holy Spirit to bestow spiritual gifts for use in life and service.
- 8. We believe in the baptism of the Holy Spirit as seen in the book of Acts.
- 9. We believe in divine healing through the power of the Holy Spirit.
- 10. We believe there will be a final judgment, when those not found written in the Book of Life will be consigned to everlasting punishment with the devil and his angels, the beast, and the false prophet.

Thank you so much for considering Anacortes Christian School for your child. It has been such an amazing journey getting this school to the point that it is today. Although it took many long days of planning, researching, and praying, it is all worth it to hear the students play, learn, and openly pray and sing praise to God.
